The Capital City Minstrels (CCM), Delhi's best known choir, comprises people from all walks of life, all with one thing in common – their love of music. ERVIN BAKTAY (1890 - 1963)

The **Hungarian Information and Cultural Centre** in cooperation with the **India International Centre** is organizing a **lecture and photo documentary exhibition** on **noted Hungarian Indologist and Art Historian, Ervin Baktay** titled **"ENCHANTED BY INDIA"**. The programme is commemorating **the 50th death anniversary of Ervin Baktay**. He was a Hungarian author noted for introducing and popularizing Indian art, culture and philosophy in Hungary in the first half of the 20th century. **He was the maternal uncle of Amrita Sher-Gil** who started his career as a painter. He recognized Amrita's talent at an early age and encouraged her to pursue art.

The **India International Centre** will be hosting lectures by **Prof. Géza Bethlenfalvy**, an **Indologist from Hungary, President of the Ervin Baktay Foundation for Oriental Art, Vice President of the Alexander Csoma de Kőrös Society**, and **Dr. Margit Köves**, a lecturer in **Delhi University** on **Tuesday, 7th May** from **4:00 – 6:00 pm**. This will be followed by the **unveiling of Baktay's plaque**, an **exhibition opening** and a **film screening** on the life of **Ervin Baktay** which will take place at the **Hungarian Information and Cultural Centre** from **6:30 – 7:30pm**.
